

◆ 3 – 2 – 1

Use: After reading (or after instruction)

This is another way to ease students into **summarizing** information.

Preparation:

None

Procedure:

At the end of the lesson, students write:

3 key terms from what they have just learned,

2 ideas they would **like to learn more about**, and

1 concept or skill they feel they understand well enough to **teach it to someone else**.

You can adapt this in many ways. They can tell 3 things they learned, 2 things they already knew, and 1 thing they thought was strange – or anything you think fits your lesson!!!!

This can be used as a “ticket out the door.”
