## Why Isn't EVERYONE Having Fun? Three Level Reading Guide



**Before reading:** In the space to the left of each statement, place a check mark ( ✓ ) if you agree or think the statement is true.

**During and after reading:** Add a new ✓ or cross through those about which you have changed your mind.
